


INTRODUCTION

In 2007, the Commission on Trial Court Performance and Accountability issued the first annual publication of the *Mediation Circuit Profiles*. This publication was created for the purpose of providing court managers with access to a consistent collection of information on state funded court mediation programs within Florida's trial courts. Each profile contains circuit specific information on fiscal allotments, direct service staffing models, FTE classifications, service coverage levels, case referral practices, fee collection practices, indigency determination practices, measurable workload outputs, and contractual rates.

In Florida's trial courts, state-funded mediation programs are evolving as the courts continue to adjust to changes in the funding structure. Prior to 2004, mediation programs were funded by the counties and because some counties provided more funding than others, significant variations existed in the delivery of services across the state. Upon the implementation of Revision 7 to Article V of the Florida Constitution in 2004, circuits transitioned to being funded by the state. This funding shift allowed for greater equity in service delivery across the circuits and thus, enabled the trials courts to work more systematically towards similar mediation goals. To keep pace with evolving mediation programs, the profiles serve as a resource tool as we continue to explore and implement best business practices.

DEFINITIONS

To assist in reviewing the information contained in each profile, the following definitions (listed here in the same order they appear on the profile) are provided:

Circuit-Wide Fiscal Allotments FY 2007-08 – Indicates original FY 2007-08 allotments after Special Session C budget reductions. This includes total state funded general revenue (GR) and trust. FTE amounts are listed by funding type (GR and trust authority). Budget amounts are listed by funding type (GR and trust authority) as well as by budget category (salaries, benefits, expenses, contractual and trust authority).

Trust Fund Revenue FY 2006-07 – Indicates total cash revenue received as of June 30, 2007 and includes prior year cash received in FY 2007-08.

Direct Service Staffing Model – Indicates the staffing model(s) used to deliver direct mediation services for the Uniform Data Reporting case types listed. There are three types of staffing models: 1) Pure employee model, 2) Pure contractual model, and 3) Pure volunteer model.

Total Staff (Total FTE Employees) – Indicates the total number of state funded mediation FTEs by classification apportioned by the county in which they are assigned.

Service Coverage – Indicates the level of service coverage being provided by a circuit's mediation program for each Uniform Data Reporting case type. There are five categories that indicate the degree of service coverage: 1) None, 2) Low, 3) Medium, 4) High, and 5) Full.

Operations – Case Referral Practices – Indicates how cases are referred by the court to mediation for the Uniform Data Reporting case types listed. Generally, cases may be referred to mediation in the following manner:

1. Automatic by AO – All cases are automatically referred by administrative order.
2. All Contested Cases – All contested cases are referred by the judge or administrative order.
3. Individually by Judge – Upon individual case review and selection by the presiding judge.
4. Upon Request/Motion of Party/Attorney – Upon request or motion from either party or their attorneys.

Operations – Fee Collection Practices – Indicates when mediation fees are collected by the clerk for the Uniform Data Reporting case types listed. Generally, fees may be collected as follows: 1) Prior to mediation, 2) Same day as mediation, and/or 3) After mediation.

Operations - Indigency Determination Practices – Indicates when the indigency status of parties is determined by the clerk for the Uniform Data Reporting case types listed. Generally indigency is determined as follows: 1) Prior to filing, 2) Prior to or upon court order to mediation, 3) Same day as mediation, and/or 4) After mediation.

UDR & Other Statistics FY 2006-07– UDR – Refers to the summary of a circuit's total mediation Uniform Data Reporting statistics for FY 2006-07.

Number of Court-Ordered Cases- Indicates for the case types listed, the number of cases reviewed to determine eligibility for participation in the Alternative Dispute Resolution program.

Number of Mediation Session Held – Indicates, for the case types listed, the number of mediation sessions held by a circuit's Alternative Dispute Resolution court program, including telephonic mediation sessions. This does not include mediation sessions scheduled but not held.

DEFINITIONS

UDR & Other Statistics FY 2006-07 – Other Statistics - Indicates for the case types listed, the amount of time allotted for each mediation session and on average the number of sessions scheduled per case.

Number of Hours Allotted for Each Session – Hourly increments ranging from 30 minutes up to 4 hours.

Average Number of Sessions Scheduled Per Case – Number of sessions ranging from 1 up to 4 hours.

Contractual Services Provider – Fee/Rate Structure – This section indicates the rate and/or rate ranges that a circuit has established for the payment of contract vendors providing mediation services, where applicable.
