Administrative Order AOSC07-63 provides that, "All recommendations made by the Electronic Filing Committee will be reviewed and approved by the Chair of the Florida Courts Technology Commission (FCTC), prior to submission to the Supreme Court for final action."

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that the Electronic Filing Committee (EFC) reviewed Hillsborough County's amended application request to allow for the electronic service of scanned orders via e-mail in the Probate, Guardianship & Trust Divisions. An additional review and approval was completed by the FCTC in April, 2009. Based on the documentation submitted by the Clerk's Office, the Hillsborough County system complies with the current technical and functional standards, guidelines and approved ADA-Section 508 compliance standards.


Approval of this electronic initiative is contingent upon compliance with the policy considerations and directives regarding the development and application of new technological standardization and enhancements as set forth by the Supreme Court. Since this process is categorized at a low complexity level and falls under the definition approved by the Supreme Court, no further review or action is required.

Therefore, as Chair and on behalf of the Florida Courts Technology Commission, the Hillsborough County amended request to allow for the electronic service of scanned orders by e-mail in the Probate, Guardianship & Trust Divisions is approved.
