RE: Clay County – Slash S Electronic Signature Method for E-filing

Dear Mr. Jett:

I received your letter dated September 9, 2009 requesting approval to implement Slash S and eliminate wet or digital signature. Usually this would require an E-process application to be submitted by your office and follow the appropriate course of action for approval.

However, since you have already been approved to implement e-filing of civil cases (AOSC07-20) and subsequently approved to discontinue follow-up paper filing requirements (AOSC08-15), OSCA staff directed your office to submit a letter for Slash S in place of an application.

Approval of this electronic initiative is contingent upon compliance with the policy considerations and directives regarding the development and application of new technological standardization and enhancements as set for by the Supreme Court. Since this process is categorized at a low complexity level and falls under the definition approved by the Supreme Court on September 5, 2007, no further review or action is required. Therefore, as Chair and on behalf of the Florida Courts Technology Commission, the Clay County request to implement the use of Slash S Electronic Signature for Civil Cases is approved.
