

## **Parenting Coordination Discipline and Review Board (PCDRB)**

The Florida Dispute Resolution Center (DRC) is currently accepting applications for 5 member appointments to the Parenting Coordination Discipline and Review Board (PCDRB) Commencing July 1, 2018. Of the appointments:

- At least 3 appointments must members of the judiciary who are assigned to family court cases; and
- At least 2 appointments must be attorneys who shall be members of The Florida Bar in good standing for at least three years and have a substantial family law practice for at least three years preceding their appointment to the Board.

The Parenting Coordinator Disciplinary Review Board (PCDRB) was appointed in 2016 to consider complaints against Qualified and Court-Appointed Parenting Coordinators. The ten members include judges, attorneys and parenting coordinators from across the state.

Appointments are made by the Chief Justice of the Supreme Court of Florida for a four-year term. Please see AOSC16-95 for more information.
